

Electric Candle - String



The Electric String candles are very easy to make. It should be pointed out that these must be made as Electric Candles as the Craft Lace is plastic and should not be burned!

You will need:

Mold - We usually suggest a "thick walled" grubby mold for embeds, but we used our "thin walled" mold for these to get a better glow (either would work).

Plastic Craft Lace - We get this from craft stores. Be sure to get the bright, translucent ones.

Wax - We like the "hassle free" votive wax from Candles and Supplies.

Cord and Bulb

Process:

Melt and prepare your wax (scent, dyes, etc).

Place individual strands of the Craft Lace into the mold, some crossover is OK but don't over do it. The strands will mostly stay in place after being placed in the mold, just be careful not to let them "bunch up".

Carefully pour your wax into the mold, while trying to avoid pouring too fast (so not to disrupt the placement of the Craft Lace).

Let cool, de-mold, and insert the cord and bulb as normal.
